

Community Service Recognition Awards

When you volunteer for a charitable organization, you should submit a Community Service form detailing your activity. Forms should be submitted within 30 days of completion. If you have questions about whether an activity qualifies for Community Service, contact Ms. Halloran. Each May, a super-commons is held in which students who qualify for Community Service Certificates are recognized. Recognition is given to students who meet the benchmarks as listed below:

Freshmen: If you complete 25 hours or more over the course of your freshman year, you will receive a certificate (hours start in September of freshman year).

Sophomores, Juniors, Seniors: If you complete 100 hours or more, you will receive a certificate (can include hours completed over the summer preceding each year). If you don't make the 100 hours in a single year, you will receive a certificate the following year if your total reaches 100 (your hours carry over).

In addition, if you complete 500 or more hours over the course of your 4 years at North Shore (September of 9th grade through May of 12th grade), you will be recognized at Moving Up Day by the Kiwanis Club as a Senior of Distinction. Only a few students in each graduating class achieve this honor.
