We are excited that your child will be joining us at Glenwood Landing School for kindergarten in September 2022. In order to be sure the transition is a smooth one, you and your child are invited to participate in a variety of activities designed to help you become familiar with our school. Please review the list of upcoming kindergarten orientation activities below.

AFTER REGISTERING AT THE DISTRICT LEVEL WITH KATHERINE MILLER, PLEASE CALL THE MAIN OFFICE (516) 277-7601 TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT FOR THE BUILDING LEVEL REGISTRATION AND STUDENT SCREENING.

1. BUILDING LEVEL REGISTRATION AND STUDENT SCREENING will take place APRIL 4-8, 2022.

(Required for child and parent, appointment time will be assigned to you, 60 minutes)

Parent will meet with Ms. Yvette D'Amico, secretary and Ms. Lisa Ledden, nurse. Please bring the approved District Residency Packet from your visit with Ms. Katherine Miller, district registrar and the completed additional paperwork that Ms. Miller provided you with to the building registration. Your child will participate in a series of mini-assessments to evaluate basic readiness skills. Please report to the kindergarten circle at your scheduled time and your child will be escorted to the screening area.

2. EVENING PARENT ORIENTATION-(Google Meet) MONDAY, MAY 16, 2022, 7:00 pm

Please join us for an informational virtual parent meeting with Bridget Finder, Principal of Glenwood Landing School. Join us to learn more about our school. Google Meet link will be shared a week before the parent orientation.

3. CLASSROOM VISIT I-(Orientation Day) TUESDAY, MAY 24, 2022.

(Required for child and parent, appointment time will be assigned to you, 60 minutes)

Your child will participate in typical kindergarten activities. While your child is enjoying this experience, you will learn more about our school, what to expect in kindergarten and how to prepare your child through an informational session with the principal and support staff.

4. CLASSROOM VISIT II-(Shadowing Day) WEDNESDAY, JUNE 8, 2022, 1:00-2:00 pm

(Required for child only, parents optional)

Students will participate in typical kindergarten activities with other incoming students. Parents are invited to meet with the School Community Association (parent group) in the library to find out how to get involved in our community and learn more about the extracurricular activities we offer.
