COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This spring return to your outdoors and all your do it yourself landscape projects. First up -- winter pruning. Perhaps you are a new homeowner or the pandemic delayed your pruning last year. Late winter is a great time to rejuvenate old shrubs and trees while dormant. 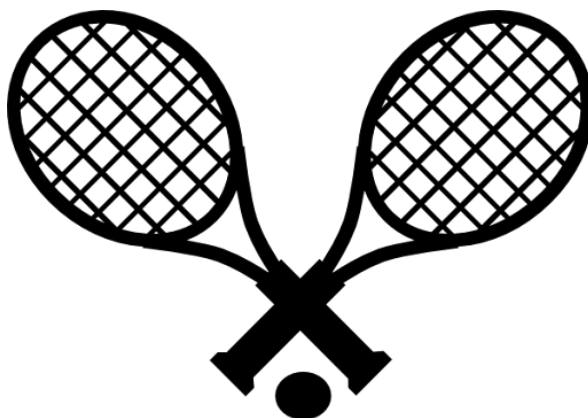

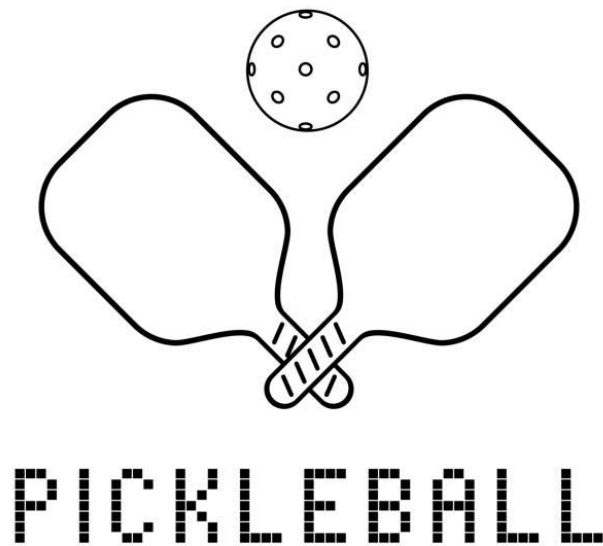

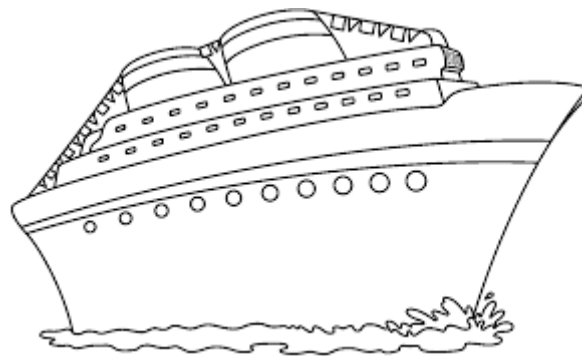
United Power Squadron Course – Includes PWC Operation

This course covers boat handling, rules of the road, compass and chart familiarization, Aids in navigation, running lights and equipment, inland boating and piloting, boat Trailing, personal watercraft operation (Jet Ski, See Doo, etc.) and Federal and State boating laws. Successful completion of this course (including passing grade on exam) satisfies the 8 hour requirement by New York State for operation of a personal watercraft and entitles you to a certificate usually honored by insurance companies for a 5-10% discount. Minimum age for children to operate watercraft is 14 years old. **Children under 16 must be accompanied by a registered adult.**
