1. The North Shore Community Education Program is a self-sufficient program and course fees are set with this goal in mind.
2. The fee for each course is listed with the course description.
3. An additional fee of \$5.00 per course will be charged for non-residents.

Refunds and Transfers:

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course focuses on spring and summer 2023 landscape projects for the do-it-yourselfer and non-do-it-yourselfer. First up -- winter pruning. Perhaps you are a new homeowner or last summer's drought delayed your pruning. Late winter is a great time to rejuvenate old shrubs and trees while dormant. Pruning is followed by four additional Power Point lectures covering Basic Principles of Landscape Design; Foundation Planting; DIY Masonry and Hardscape; and Constructing a Simple Veggie Garden. This spring students will choose the final class's topic--- 2023 Herbaceous Perennials, Pool-Scaping, or 2023 Ornamental Trees and Shrubs.

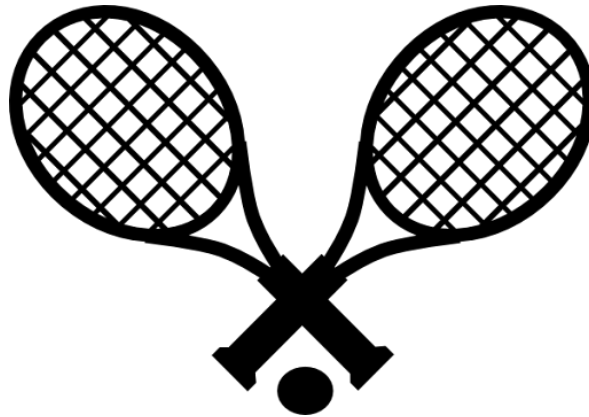

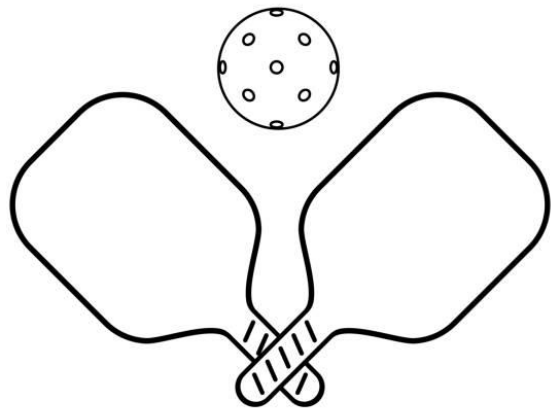

satisfies the 8 hour requirement by New York State for operation of a personal watercraft and entitles you to a certificate usually honored by insurance companies for a 5-10% discount.

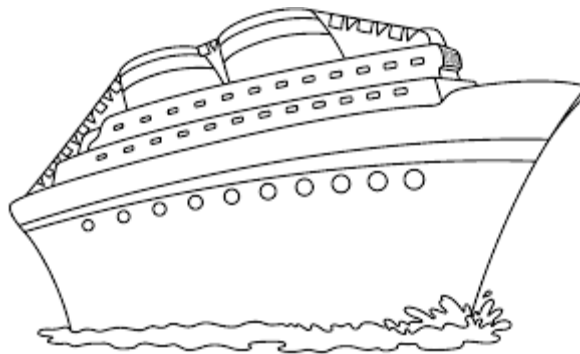

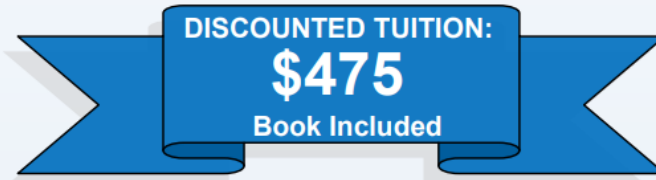
