



DESCRIPTION

This Parent University focused on RULER, the evidence-based approach to social and emotional learning developed at Yale by Marc Brackett. RULER is currently being implemented in each of our elementary schools and will be introduced in sixth grade next year.

The Parent University was facilitated by Dan Doherty, our Director of Counseling, Bridget Finder, principal of Glenwood Landing School, and Carolyn DiPreta, our elementary guidance counselor. They provided an overview of the approach currently used in the elementary schools, including the four RULER tools: the Mood Meter, the Charter, the Meta-Moment, and the Blueprint. Parents learned how routines are established and resources are used within the school day. In addition, the facilitators shared practical strategies for use at home and provided each participant with a mood meter for use with their children.




