### **REVENUE GENERATION COMMITTEE (RGC)**

**Focus:** The Revenue Generation Committee is a new committee established by the School Board to assist in the creation, planning, and administration of non-taxable revenue sources that are sustainable in a way that allows the District to keep taxes down, while also preserving student programs. With the loss of tax revenue from the Glenwood Landing LIPA Plant, generating our own revenue is more essential now than ever!

- The District is looking for qualified community members with financial and business expertise to work with the Board and Administration.
- Committee meets as often as possible at least five times a year.
- Please submit a brief revenue generation plan with your application for the Board of Education to review.

### **COMMUNITY BUDGET FORUM (CBF)**

**Focus:** The District established the Community Budget Forum (CBF) Committee to work with our administrators to assist with the important responsibility of developing greater awareness of the budget process through education and training. Members will be charged with learning the general Public School budgeting processes, specific details, procedures, and challenges faced by the North Shore Schools.

- The District is looking for varied community members to work with our administrators and staff.
- Training will be provided by the District. After completing training, CBF members will assist in efforts to inform and engage the community at-large by sharing information about the District's finances, processes, and upcoming budget.
- Attendance at Board meetings identified as budget events will be expected. The CBF generally meets monthly.

## LEGISLATIVE ACTION COMMITTEE (LAC)

**Focus:** The North Shore Board of Education established the Legislative Action Committee, or LAC, as a Citizen's Advisory Committee of the Board for the purpose of researching, proposing, and executing approved advocacy approaches to legislative matters that have a direct bearing on fiscal or educational aspects of the North Shore Central School District.

- LAC is composed of residents with varying interests, experience, and expertise. Trustees are looking for qualified residents who can communicate with community members via several ways including letters, emails, school events, meetings, and community groups.
- Committee generally meets monthly usually on Tuesday evenings.

### **AUDIT COMMITTEE**

**Focus:** The Audit Committee was established by the School Board to oversee the annual independent audits of the District's records. The committee shall recommend the selection of the independent and internal auditors and continue a thorough review of significant internal and external audit findings.

- The District is looking for 1 highly qualified candidate with experience in municipal finance and audits to work with the Board and our auditors.
- Committee meets four times a year on Thursday evenings.
