Minutes  
May 23, 2024

The meeting was called to order by Vice-president Lisa Colacioppo at 8:00 a.m. in the Central Office Conference Room. Present were Trustees Cashman, Galati, and Ludmar. Also present Trustee-elect James Svendsen, Superintendent Dr. Christopher Zublionis and Assistant Superintendents Dr. Carol Smyth and Mr. James Pappas. President Macari and Trustee Mosca were absent.

**Pledge of Allegiance**

Vice-president Colacioppo led the public in the pledge of allegiance.

**Regular Business**

On motion of Trustee Ludmar and seconded by Trustee Cashman and all in favor, it was: Acceptance of Election Results of the May 21, 2024 Budget Vote and Election of Trustees WHEREAS, the Annual District Election of the North Shore Central School District, was duly called to be held on May 21, 2024, and was held on said date in said School District for the purpose of voting on the Proposition and Election set forth in the notice calling said Annual District Election: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Board of Education of The North Shore Central School District, As Follows:

It is hereby determined that said election was held in all respects in the manner prescribed by the Education Law of the State of New York.

The respective statements of the Inspectors of Election have been presented to the Board of Education of said School District and said Board accepts them as follows:

Proposition 1 (School Budget)

Members of the Board of Education:

James Svendsen: 1917

It is hereby further determined that Proposition No. 1 (School Budget) was approved by a majority of the votes cast thereon and it is hereby declared to be adopted and that the proposed 2024-2025 budget for school purposes in the total amount of \$122,648,900.09 be approved and, that said sum be expended during the ensuing school year, and the necessary taxes upon the taxable property of the school district be levied to meet said expenditures after first deducting the monies available from state aid and other sources.

It is hereby further determined that Lisa Colacioppo has received the highest number of votes cast for member of the Board of Education and is hereby declared to be elected to a Three-Year term, commencing July 1, 2024.

It is hereby further determined that Maria Mosca has received the second highest number of votes cast for member of the Board of Education and is hereby declared to be elected to a Three-Year term, commencing July 1, 2024.

It is hereby further determined that James Svendsen has received the third highest number of votes cast for member of the Board of Education and is hereby declared to be elected to a term commencing May 23, 2024 and expiring on June 30, 2025.

**Swearing in of New Trustee**

James Svendsen was sworn in by the District Clerk.
