North Shore Schools Board of Education Regular Meeting Minutes May 30, 2024

The meeting was called to order by President Andrea Macari at 6:00 p.m. in the Middle School Cafeteria. Present were Trustees Cashman, Colacioppo, Galati, Ludmar, Mosca and Svendsen. Also present were Superintendent Dr. Christopher Zublionis and Assistant Superintendents Dr. Carol Smyth and Mr. James Pappas.

At 6:00 p.m. on motion of Trustee Colacioppo and seconded by Trustee Ludmar and all in favor, the Board convened an executive session in the faculty lounge to consider matters regarding the employment or appointment of a particular person or persons, proposed, pending or current litigation, and collective negotiations pursuant to Article 14 of the Civil Service Law (The Taylor Law).

At 8;00 p.m. on motion of Trustee Cashman and seconded by Trustee Mosca and all in favor, the Board came out of executive session and resumed the regular meeting in the cafeteria. There were approximately 150 people in the audience.

Pledge of Allegiance

President Macari led the public in the pledge of allegiance.

President Macari welcomed all to the meeting. She noted that this is the first regular meeting since the successful budget vote and election of trustees. President Macari said this community has a long tradition of supporting our schools, however the last few years the margin was very tight. This year, she is happy to report that the budget passed by 898 votes. She expressed her appreciation for everyone's efforts for crafting and passing a budget which takes the work of many stakeholders. President Macari thanked the amazing Central Office team, Superintendent Dr. Chris Zublionis, Assistant Superintendents, Dr. Carol Smyth and, Mr. Jamie Pappas, who all worked hard to preserve our programs that we value and crafted a responsible budget that the board felt comfortable with and represented the students and tax payers. She thanked the District Clerk, the poll workers, IT team, the custodial staff, the security staff, Shelly Newman and communication team, amazing staff, teachers, administrators, the coalition of parent organizations, parents, and residents who came to the 20 meetings Dr. Zublionis held and who offered suggestions, advice and support, all of the Trustees who had a lot of sleepless nights, and the 3414 residents who came out and voted. She thanked everyone on behalf of our students and the community. Finally, President Macari noted that although it was an uncontested election, three Trustees were elected. Vicepresident Lisa Colacioppo was re-elected, Trustee Mosca was also re-elected and a new Trustee, James Svendsen, was elected and sworn in at a special election last week. Trustee Svendsen will be finishing the term vacated by Marianne Russo. She welcomed Trustee Svendsen to the Board.

Approval of Minutes

to all members in advance of the meeting, were dispensed. There being no corrections to the minutes, it was declared by President Macari that the minutes of the meeting of May 9, 2024, audit committee meeting minutes of May 9, 2024, and May 23, 2024 were approved.

Report from the SGO

SGO president Ava DiFeo was not in attendance.

Report of the Superintendent

Dr. Zublionis congratulated the North Shore Girls Spring Track Team who won the Nassau County Class A Championship. 13 of the girls received All-County status and Coach Levy earned his 40th Nassau County Championship. The team scored 126 points, more than the 2nd and 3rd place teams combined and won by 66 points, the most in school history. Dr. Zublionis also congratulated the Girls Lacrosse Team and Boys Baseball and Lacrosse Teams for making the playoffs. He reported that all spring teams did very well this year.

Dr. Zublionis congratulated all of the musicians who performed at high levels in the spring concerts. He noted from third grade to twelfth grade it was amazing to see and hear the growth in the musicians. He reported that at the next Board meeting on June 13 they will discuss progress on goals of the North Shore Journey; a survey regarding this will be sent home tomorrow.

A Parent University is scheduled for next Thursday, June 6. The workshop will be facilitated by Northwell Health and explore the impacts of technology.

Finally, Dr. Zublionis thanked everyone for supporting the school district to protect and preserve the experience for our students. He said an outcome like this gives them so much energy to focus on the great work that is being done. He said it is an honor to work in this community and he hopes this will unite the community.

Student Recognition

On behalf of the Board of Education, President Macari along with Superintendent Dr. Zublionis and Assistant Superintendent Carol Smyth, recognized the following students: Long Island Math Fair Medalists; Nassau County Math Teachers Assn. Math Tournament participants; New York State Foreign Language Teachers Assn. Virtual Video Contest Winners; NYU Rock that Movie Competition Winners; National Council of Teachers of English Writing Contest Winner; Science Research Student Achievement Awards; and NYSSMA Faculty Achievements.

Regular Business – 8:54 p.m. Discussion: The Transition to College and Career

Director of Counseling, Mr. Dan Doherty, gave a presentation on "The Transition to Life Beyond North Shore - College and Career". He reviewed the option for students after graduation which include 2-and 4-year colleges, vocational, military, career/workforce and gap years which indicate that over the past 7 years between 94-97% of students have opted to go to a 2- or 4-year college. He reviewed the data of the most applied to and most attended colleges, the average number of applications per student, the average acceptance rate per student and students overall, and the colleges North Shore students are attending. Mr. Doherty reviewed the unique talents of the class of 2024 which include 15 NCAA Athletes, 34 Art of Muric Major or Minors, Selective BA/MD Programs, Art Institutes and Music Conservatories. Mr. Doherty reviewed North Shore acceptance rates compared to the National average at many of the most competitive colleges and universities which indicated North Shore is at or above the National average. He also reviewed comparative data with neighboring schools. Mr. Doherty explained the components of the college application with the most important being the GPA (recalculated by the college) and strength of schedule. He further explained that SAT/ACT score reporting is now optional. He reviewed how counselors support the college application process in school and out of school. Counselors go on college visits to promote North Shore High School and to get first-hand information on colleges and the admission/recruitment process for individual schools. The counseling department also hosts college representative visits and college fairs as well as an Alumni Panel. Mr. Doherty reviewed some recent legislation and court decisions that might impact college admissions such as the Supreme Court ending affirmative action, SAT/ACT test option admissions, and colleges ending legacy admissions. He discussed the early decision process and the acceptance rate compared to regular decision acceptance. Finally, Mr. Doherty discussed the pathways to career and workforce.

9:48 p.m.

The Board discussed the presentation. All Trustees thanked Mr. Doherty and the counselors for the information and backup material. Some questions/comments raised were: what can the Board do to help the counseling department and to help students increase acceptance rates to college; how does regionality hinder our students getting into certain schools; what role does the High School Profile play; early decision seems like it benefits colleges but not students, what is the consequence if a student withdraws from an early decision; which schools are no longer taking legacy into their acceptance decisions; does the counseling department provide a check list of

what to look for during college visits; do all students need to declare a major when applying; how common is it for students to use outside college counseling tools for SAT preparation; is there an opportunity to expand our relationships with more colleges – there seems to be a high exception rate to colleges who visit North Shore; the business community has expressed an interest in internships, is this something that can be explored; can the High School Profile include how we differ from other schools; convey to colleges what makes us unique; what are we doing to prepare students for what they will be doing after college and what the cost of that degree is; how many students' first choice does not work out; how many students finish a 2 year college and go on to a 4 year college; how many students are finishing a 4 year degree; of those who do not go on to college what are they pursuing; how successful are those who are in BOCES programs, are they going on to college; are students in the special education program getting into the college they want; why are students not ranked in the top 10%; with GPA so close, why do we not have more than one Valedictorian; possibility of producing a video that speaks to the unique opportunities of a North Shore education.

Director of Counseling, Mr. Dan Doherty, and Guidance Counselors, Mr. Tim Shea and Ms. Joanne Fawcett responded to questions. The counselors thanked the Board for their continued support. They said the college visits are valuable tools and feel some type of integrated support for standardized tests would be helpful as students who go test optional can be at a disadvantage. Mr. Doherty agreed that schools on Long Island are more competitive and regionality does factor in; early decision can help. Ms. Fawcett added that Long Island students are in high demand. Regarding early decision, Mr. Doherty explained it is a binding contract and ethically students are committing to attend the school. Counselors must sign a document stating they have informed students of this fact. He also explained that many early decisions are for low income, first generation, college students, and/or athletes. Mr. Shea added that if a student breaks that contract, the next student from our school may not be accepted. He also explained that it is a good tool for colleges to manage how many students will be attending in the fall. Regarding the legacy question, Mr. Doherty explained that it depends on the school. Some schools still use that in their decisions, and some are changing their criteria. He further explained since the Supreme Court decision on affirmative action, that may be the next thing to fall. Counselors do give recommendations to students when they go on college visits, this usually is customized after meeting with families. The trend has changed with regard to applying with a major, and this can make it more difficult to get into a school, but it does seem to work out. Students also apply undeclared. Families don't usually share with counselors if students are utilizing SAT prep. Counselors do have a good relationship with each of their students, and have time to spend with them, because their case loads are manageable. Mr. Doherty explained that counselors listen to families for what their goals are and what they can afford so the expectations are fair. Counselors point families in the right direction. Our students are attending 2- and 4-year colleges above the national average. Some students who attend BOCES programs are going to 2- and 4-year colleges, some are going into a trade and the majority of special education students are going to a 2-4 year college. Very few high schools rank students in the top 10%, schools that work on an A,B,C or 4.0 grading system have multiple Valedictorians. Colleges look at GPA and test scores, not the title of Valedictorian. In addition, colleges recalculate the GPA.

Comments from the Public 11:00 p.m.

There was no public present at this point of the meeting.

Trustee Cashman publicly acknowledged the high number of Seals of Biliteracy that have been awarded this year and congratulated Ms. Aguiar for this impressive accomplishment by our students.

Prior to approval, Dr. Zublionis recognized the three teachers retiring. He praised Christine Halloran, a math teacher, coordinator of the senior internship program and community service program. He said she has helped multiple students in a unique way. Marla Behar was one of the first special education teachers in the district and has worked in so many different settings. She was also very helpful with the special education review that was just completed. Laura Green has provided so many unique journeys for our students. Dr. Zublionis noted that the district is losing a lot of giants this year and it will be hard to replace people of this magnitude.
