The meeting was called to order by President Andrea Macari at 8:00 a.m. in the Central Office Conference Room. Present were Trustees Cashman, Colacioppo, Dillon, Hanley, Mosca and Svendsen. Also present were Superintendent Dr. Christopher Zublionis and Assistant Superintendents Dr. Carol Smyth and Mr. James Pappas.

**Pledge of Allegiance**

Per Diem Appointment - Administration

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Education of the North Shore Central School District hereby approves the per diem appointment of Laura Sullivan, Interim Assistant Elementary Special Education Director, at a rate agreed upon with the Board of Education in executive session, effective January 7, 2026 through June 30, 2026

Prior to voting, Trustee Mosca asked what the facilities will be used for. Dr. Zublionis explained the facilities will primarily be used for the Varsity Basketball Team to have another space in the rotation as there is so much competition for space.

On motion of Trustee Colacioppo and seconded by Trustee Cashman and all in favor, it was:

Approval of a Facility Use Agreement between the North Shore Central School District and the Greek Orthodox Church of the Holy Resurrection of Brookville

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Education of the North Shore Central School District hereby approves a facilities use agreement between the School District and the Greek Orthodox Church of the Holy Resurrection of Brookville, New York, Inc., for the use of their gym facility for a total of 11 days between January 7, 2026 and January 30, 2026 as per the terms and conditions set forth in the attached agreement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Education authorizes the President of the Board of Education to execute the necessary documents to effectuate said agreement on behalf of the Board of Education.
