GOAL One

Search for and Appointment of the next Superintendent of Schools

- Search for and then execute a contract with a search firm that will assist the Board in conducting a thorough search.
- Engage the community through the search firm, finding ways to seek input from all constituencies and provide the community with regular updates as the search continues.
- Appoint the next Superintendent in a timely fashion, so as to allow for an appropriate and effective transition.

GOAL Two

Critical Analysis of Instructional Program

- Conduct an internal audit and self-study of the Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Programs.
- Analyze the effectiveness of each program individually and the impact of their continued interaction when both are offered, including research on how colleges view these programs.
- Explore other opportunities for students to earn college credit while in high school, including, but not limited to, dual credit programs with local colleges, including the State University of New York.
- Determine the opportunity cost and actual cost associated with our extensive offerings, including the impact on Special Education and other programs.

GOAL Three

Community Outreach, with a focus on Community Engagement

- Maintain a welcoming atmosphere and transparent practice at all meetings of the Board of Education.
- Establish meeting opportunities outside of Board Meetings to expand opportunities to positively interact with the greater school community.
- Utilize multiple means to engage with community and rely upon the data that is collected to inform decisions and do so throughout the year utilizing a variety of mediums.
