GENERAL INFORMATION

Class starting date is shown under each course.

Fees:

1. The North Shore Community Education Program is a self-sufficient program and course fees are set with this goal in mind.
2. The course fees are listed next to each course title.
3. An additional fee of \$5.00 per course will be charged for non-residents.

Refunds and Transfers:

1. Absolutely no fees will be refunded after the commencement of classes. If a course is cancelled, you will be refunded or prorated if the course has already started.
2. A written request for a refund must be made minimum one week before class starts. This request must be emailed in writing to gesueles@northshoreschools.org and kulikowskys@northshoreschools.org Telephone cancellations **will not** be accepted.
3. There is no provision for a partial fee for taking one session or part of a course.
4. **All refunds due to enrollees after six weeks of registration will be processed through the District's general fund.** Enrollees will be required to complete the required forms and return the signed and completed forms to the office for Community Education in order to receive their funds.
5. **Registration fees will only be accepted by the office for Community Education.** Instructors are not permitted to accept any registration fees. Please plan ahead and mail your registration form, attend the in-person registration evenings, or stop by during office hours.
6. **Please consult your physician before starting any exercise program.** North Shore School District and its employees are not liable for accidents or injury which may occur during the Community Education Program.

Eligibility:

Priority is given to residents of the North Shore School District, 21 years and older. High School students may apply where there is a course opening, provided they have permission from the Director of Community Education. Elementary students are not eligible for the program. Middle School Students are eligible under extremely rare circumstances and must be approved by the Superintendent of Schools and the Director of Community Education. If this student is approved, he/she must be accompanied by a parent/guardian at all times. In addition, the student's representative must go through the process for approval at the start of each year.

The course's objective is to develop in each student the personal confidence to successfully use chalk pastels.

Each week, the demonstrated technique will build upon the previous session beginning with monochromatic studies progressing to full-color shaded compositions.

The subject matter will concentrate on a variety of still-lives stressing successful two-dimensional design principles such as format, proportion, balance, rhythm and emphasis.

We will conclude with expressive gesture drawings of the human figure using projections on the classroom video screen (Smartboard).

No experience is necessary. The instructor will collect a small fee (\$15 - \$20 depending on total enrollment) to cover the purchase of chalk pastels and specialized pastel papers.

The objective, throughout this workshop, is to inspire my students to experiment with the watercolor medium. This course is designed for both beginning as well as advanced students.

The students, if they wish, will paint along while following my demonstration, or just observe and take notes. At the end of each session, I will encourage the students to paint a simple object and bring it in the following week for a critique.

All the basic foundations of the watercolor medium will be covered until the student has a basic comprehension of how the pigments interact with water.

Some of the key points I will cover are:

1. How to plan a composition.
2. Basic drawing skills
3. How to create flat, gradated and multi-colored washes
4. The importance of values over color
5. How to direct the composition for emphasis on the focal point.

This introductory hand building class is designed to familiarize students with the simplicity and complexities of low fire clay. Foundational techniques of pinch, coil, slab and carve will be foremost. Students can decide which pieces to take to completion in their personal style with glaze or other surface finishes.

The teacher will supply the tools at the outset, however most students prefer to acquire their own pottery tools through amazon or other source for approx. \$ 10.00. Most kits include a round sponge, ribs, cutting wire, loop tools, wooden knife, and pin tool.

It is recommended that each student bring a small towel and dry clean plastic for their own use. Clay is messy, some aprons may be available however dress for success.

A class fee of \$ 15.00 for clay and supplies by cash or check will be required for the first night.

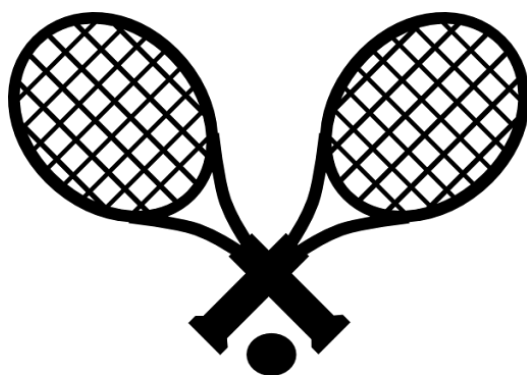

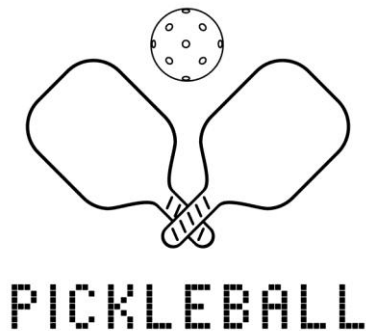
