

# **NORTH SHORE SCHOOL DISTRICT IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION**

New York State Public Health Law, Section 2164 mandates that schools shall not permit a child to be admitted unless the parent provides the school with a certificate of immunization.

The required immunizations are:

- 4-5 doses of Diphtheria and Tetanus toxoid-containing vaccine and Pertussis vaccine. 5 doses or 4 doses if the 4th dose was received at 4 years of age or older.
- 1 dose of Tdap, Tetanus and Diphtheria toxoid-containing vaccine and Pertussis booster entering **6th grade**.
- 3-4 doses of Polio vaccine. 4 doses or 3 doses if the 3rd dose was received at 4 years of age or older.
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine.
- 2 doses of MMR vaccine.
- 2 doses of Varicella vaccine are required to enter **grades K-12**. If your child had Varicella (Chickenpox), proof of natural illness must be documented by the healthcare provider and submitted to the school nurse.
- 1 dose of Meningococcal conjugate vaccine, entering **7th grade** and 1 dose entering **12th grade or 16 years of age or older**.

All of the above immunizations must be documented by your health care provider. All immunizations must specify the exact date each immunization was administered.

**Your child will not be permitted to attend school without the necessary verification of immunizations.**
